

When Scott Diament, President of the Palm Beach Jewelry, Art & Antique Show already the largest and most successful antique show in the country - wanted a new and meaningful charity dimension to the Show, he thought of the Hope for Depression Research Foundation (HDRF). He had heard HDRF Founder and Chairman Audrey Gruss and leading neuroscientists speak at a Palm Beach HDRF Seminar. He was especially moved by the fact that the artistic and creative

Scott Diament invited HDRF to be the charity partner of the Show. to the issue of depression. Audrey Gruss' first call was to Scott Snyder, a long-time friend and Palm Beach Chair of the HDRF Arts Committee. Scott Snyder invited four of the leading lights in the design field to join him and make the Hope Designer Showcase happen.
